

CHANGES TO TRAFFIC AROUND CARMEL HIGH SCHOOL FOR SPRING 2009 EVENTS

Due to ongoing construction on Keystone Avenue at several intersections, it will be necessary for your teams to use alternate routes to the **football stadium and tennis courts** this spring. It is recommended that you utilize Range Line Road to access 136th Street which is the road running in front of the football stadium and tennis courts. We are sorry for this inconvenience for teams and fans, but it will be completed this summer in time for the start of next school year.

Traveling North on Keystone... turn left at 131st Street (also known as Main Street). Turn right at the first entrance to Carmel High School and follow the east drive to travel to the north end of campus. You will see the Duke Performing Arts Center on this drive as well as the natatorium. Follow this road along the soccer field and over the bridge to toward the road construction. Cross 136th Street at the bottom of the trail/road and you will see the tennis courts and stadium at this location.

Traveling South on US 31/Keystone... veer to the right and stay on US 31 (Meridian) rather than veering left onto Keystone at the split. Turn **right** at the Rangeline Road/Clay Terrace Boulevard light. You will be making a U-Turn at the first roundabout to come back to this same intersection (*this is due to the lane restrictions at the intersection which prohibit you from turning left initially off US 31 onto Rangeline Road*). Now cross the intersection at the light to go south on Rangeline Road to the roundabout. Turn east at the roundabout on to 136th Street (also known as Smokey Row Road) and the stadium will be ahead on the left side of the street.
