

2009 Thomas C. Murray Cup Managers Information

- 1.) Registration will be at the HQ tent of your game site. Please check in at least a half an hour before game time or earlier if possible. Carmel United teams need to register during the week before the tournament.
- 2.) To register your team, you will need **player passes**, **medical releases** and a copy of your **official state association roster**. **Out of state** teams will need a **state association travel permit** from your state. We will keep copies of your roster and travel permit. If you are entered as a US Club Soccer team you will not need the travel permit.
- 3.) Guest players will need the same passes and medical forms. Our check in personnel will write them in on your roster.
- 4.) The Murray Cup will be played at two sites. All U-10 through U-12 games will be played at Carmel High School. U-9s plus U-13 and above will play at the Carmel Clay Community Soccer Complex. All Monday finals will be at CCCSC while Sunday finals will be at the site where teams played their Saturday and Sunday games. To locate these fields, go to our Murray Cup website, www.murraycup.com, and click on "Schedule and Results" which will give you the schedule. Click on "Event Fields" at the top. This will take you to a list of fields and give you access to Mapquest for the field.
- 5.) Please check your game schedule before traveling to the tournament. Our program was sent to press May 6 and some changes may be made after that date.
- 6.) You may bring as many guest players as you wish as long as the number doesn't exceed the state roster limit. We will remove players not attending the Murray Cup from your roster when we add your guest players.
- 7.) If you are coming by bus, you will be asked to park in Carmel-Clay school lots adjacent to the two sites.
- 8.) We will have medical trainers available at both sites.
- 9.) Travel from site to site or hotel to site may be delayed by construction. We will send traffic alerts as we get closer to the date.
